Reaching Out To A Lost And Dying World

Our Missionaries Building a Church in Ecuador

In 2003 we were blessed to be able to take two trips to Ecuador. One was in March and the other was in October. In Ecuador it is the norm for the Quichua Indians to send only one child per family to school due to inability to afford school supplies. Due to your financial support it was made possible for us to purchase thousands of school supplies, providing every single child with the means to receive an education, for as long as the supplies will last. Your financial support has also made it possible to meet medical needs of the Quichua Indian Ecuadorian people. We were even able to buy additional medicine there, as the need was greater than expected and for which we were prepared, thanks to all of your support. Additionally, we were able to feed hundreds on a daily basis. We encountered such a large need for funds and because that need was met, **our missionary team of 12 from the US was able to bless every single child, every day, at every meeting.** Not one child was left behind. Toys were given to each one. Orphans and widows also received clothing.

We experienced some of the indigenous culture of the area as we watched and then imitated the women using broom sticks to mix food contained in large cast iron pots. Due to lack of money, the Ecuadorian culture allows for only one room huts with straw roofs. The inhabitants sleep with all their animals indoors to prevent theft of this precious asset. In between them and their animals, lies a rustic kitchen and grain stores for livestock. Their sleeping arrangements consist of a thin piece of wood board with straw laid on top. Whenever the bus was unable to make it up the very steep slopes, and we had to hike the mountains, we soon learned the day to day routine of the Ecuadorians outside the home. They are mountain dwellers and work plots of land for farming on steep slopes. We marveled at their farming skills, as we struggled to keep our balance just trying to walk up the slopes. During each meeting the men of our group worked on the building of a church in the city of Chismaute, Ecuador. The men accomplished the establishment of 4 concrete walls. The locals will continue the vision, completing the very first church in the area. During all our meetings several people experienced the baptism of the Holy

Spirit, many dedicated and rededicated their lives to serve God, some women reported seeing visions and feeling the fire of God over their lives, and last but not least during our last meeting a large number of teenagers responded to the call to receive Jesus Christ in their lives. When not ministering to the Ecuadorian people, our team experienced the awesome beauty of God's creation in the country's breathtaking nature. We hiked through the

Amazon River, explored the jungles, and swung on Tarzan vines. All the while, we praised God for the opportunity to touch the lives of his people across the globe that was only made possible by God's grace and by all those who supported ReBirth Intl. Ministries. **Thank you for your support! This trip was a true blessing because of YOU! Please be a part of it, if you can't go, please send us!**

Mission Teens, Norma, New Jersey is a religious, non-profit, Christian organization whose **primary goal is to help people who are desperate and willing to seek God for the answers to their lives.** This is just one of our local outreaches. This is **not just a rehabilitation center or just another outreach to people with chemical dependency problems.** It is a Christ centered residential Bible training center where individuals are discipled into the fullness of Jesus Christ. Despite the organizations title, Mission Teens is opened to ages 16-65, and is a co-ed center. ReBirth not only sends financial support to Mission Teens, but

Locally we will be focusing on community outreach. **ReBirth is stepping up the pace in ministering locally to the homeless, people who are physically/or mentally challenged, at risk children and the elderly and the needy.** Our street ministry

will lead in this challenge, directed by Rev. Alexander Carr. We hope to be more involved with our local prison ministries and to establish an outreach to the New Jersey Prison System. Our local ministry work is taking some of the stress off our overburden social service systems in Atlantic, Cumberland, Salem and Gloucester counties as well as Philadelphia, PA. We have a prayer service every Wednesday night and **every other week** we hold a **service for children and their parents in the Gloucester County Library.** Your financial support makes a difference locally and also abroad. Not only were we able to visit Ecuador in April and October of 2003, but He also made a way for us in May, 2003 to visit Poland, 11 days, 11 churches, we were truly blessed being able to minister in the midst of Polish people. We were able to conduct a short teaching in Canada as well. Toward the end of 2003 we began

to send Peru and Zambia-Mozambique money for the orphans. (65% of orphans or over 12 million in Zambia have AIDS) We are using your financial support to feed orphans on the streets with AIDS, whose parents have died. These children are found sick and alone roaming the streets. We send the money to a local church which in turn purchases one meal a day. Because of the lack of finances they are only able to feed them one meal a day every other day. PRAISE GOD!

We appreciate all that you do in being obedient to what God has placed on your hearts to do to help the children of Zambia & Mozambique. Thanks again in helping us reach out to a lost and dying world.
